## **LANSING CSD CAPITAL PROJECT VOTE INFORMATION**

There are currently 5,591 active voters in Lansing. 1004 voted in the recent capital project vote. 18% of the active voting population in Lansing voted.

### **Proposition 1: Non-Pipe Line Alternative**

509 Yes/ 495 No = Total votes 1004

50.7% of the total votes voted yes. 9.1% of the total active voters in Lansing voted yes.  
49.3% of the total votes voted no. 8.8% of the total active voters in Lansing voted no

### **Proposition 2: The Bobcat Project**

368 Yes/ 634 No = Total votes 1002

36.7% of the total votes voted yes. 6.6% of the total possible active voters in Lansing voted yes.  
63.3% of the total votes voted no. 11.3% of the total possible active voters in Lansing voted no.

### **Information gathered from the Exit Poll Survey**
